November is National Native American Heritage Month

We, The Food Bank @ St. Mary's, are a long-standing member of the <u>Seattle Food Committee</u>. The mission of the Seattle Food Committee is to end hunger by identifying and addressing the root causes, including systems of injustice and oppression. Together, our member organizations work to educate, advocate and collaborate for food and social justice.

Seattle Food Committee members acknowledge their work is done on the lands of the Coast Salish peoples, including the Duwamish (dxwdew?abš), a tribe displaced by the unfulfilled Treaty of Point Elliott signed in 1855 by Chief Si'ahl on behalf of the Duwamish and other allied tribes. Our work today is possible only because of the stewardship of the lands and waters shown by

the Duwamish for generations.
